Chi Delta Chapter – Duke University – 1973

Arms – Argent, a shield surmounted by a quill with six barbs, surmounted by a smaller shield or, the smaller shield with a center of azure. The center of the small shield contains a representation of the Duke Chapel with 6 arches of the first. On a chief sable two dexter hands hand-in-hand in fess between the Greek letters Psi and Upsilon, the former on the dexter, the latter on the sinister, or. The six arches represent the chapel and the six barbs on the quill allude to the Chapter founders. The quill and chapel are symbolic of learning.

Crest – on a wreath of argent and azure owl argent

Motto - “We wish to learn” as translated from the Greek; presented azure on a scroll argent
