**Phi Chapter – University of Michigan – 1865**

**Arms** – Quarterly; first and fourth sable two dexter hands hand-in-hand in fess between Greek capital letters Psi and Upsilon, the former in chief, the latter in base, or; second and third ermine, a crown proper. The crown and ermine are were both worn by ancient kings as symbols of honor.

**Crest** – on a wreath of or and sable an owl argent

**Motto** – “We seek honor” as translated from the Greek; presented sable on a scroll argent
