Gamma Tau Chapter – Georgia Institute of Technology – 1970

Arms – Sable, two dexter hands hand-in-hand in fess between the Greek letters Psi and Upsilon, the former in chief, the latter in base, or, impaling vert, cogwheel of the second of eight spokes and 34 gear teeth on a field argent. Half of the keyway may be seen on the unobscured half of the cogwheel. The 34 gear teeth refer to the Gamma Tau's position as the 34th chapter. The gear itself is symbol of machinery and innovation. The colors reflect the colors of the University.

Crest – on a wreath of argent and or owl argent

Motto - “We understand work” as translated from the Greek; presented sable on a scroll argent
